

Report from David Cue on Kent League Veterans Division 1 Season 2006/7

Congratulations to Medway A on regaining the Kent League Division One Championship after 2 years. Medway's team, which included Ian Gordon and Graham French, and captained by Neil LeMilliere proved much too strong for the rest of the teams in Division One.
