

Success at Newcastle Open for Jasmin Ould

Fourteen year old Jasmin Ould from the Byng Hall club in Tunbridge Wells, was the star of the show on day one of the Newcastle Open, the second main Senior Butterfly Grand Prix Event of the series, held in the eighteen table venue of the Eldon Square Leisure Centre, over the weekend of 11th-12th October.

Jasmin played extremely well in only her fourth Grand Prix of her short career to take the Women's Band Three title and runner up in the Women's Band Two. It was a magnificent achievement for one so young.

Ould, unseeded in the Women's Band Three event had to overcome tough opponents in the group stages, including Nicola Duke, Eszter Soos, and Josie Bruce. She then went on to defeat Charlotte Binley in four close sets in the semi final, and then faced a more experienced competitor in Katherine Le Fevre from the famous Ormesby Club, to come through a worthy winner, in a tough five set final.
