

## **GRAY SENIOR SHOWS CLASS AT VETERANS BRITISH LEAGUE**

Benenden's Diccon Gray may nowadays be overshadowed by his illustrious son, national under 14 champion Lewis Gray, but the former schoolboy international demonstrated that he is still a fine player at the Bribar Veterans (Over 40s) British League in Hereford over the weekend, winning 8 out of 10 of his matches in the premier division.

A trained physical education teacher who is the National Development Manager for the English Table Tennis Association, Gray travels the country managing development officers and gets little time and opportunity to train himself. However, representing Kent side Bribar Nomads, the Weald TT Club, Cranbrook lefthander lost only to former Scottish international Keith Rodger of Thompsons Insurance (Tyne & Wear) and to Philip Logsdon of Potters Leisure Resort (Norfolk). Phil Saxby (Folkestone) won 5 out of 10 singles, while Phil Cox (Orpington) won 2 out of 10, in helping Bribar Nomads finishing 4<sup>th</sup> in the first weekend of the premier division, with 2 wins, 2 draws and one loss.
