Fusion table tennis club presents the 5th **Burger King Fusion All Star** Tournament over the weekend of the 26th and 27th of June 2010 at Ernest Bevin, Beechcroft Road, Tooting Bec, London, SW17 7DF.

Some of the main contenders are expected to be:

- Gavin Rungay, Scottish No 1 & World Ranked 262, who is hoping to retain his title after his dramatic victory in the 2009 Fusion All Star.
- David Zombori from Hungary, World Ranked 260, 21 years old and regular ITTF Pro Tour player.
- Filip Szymanski, Polish International, World Ranked 228 – dynamic player who has won a number of English tournaments in past seasons.
- Battersea's England star, Darius Knight, World Ranked 274 is expected to lead the local challenge against a stellar line up of table tennis heavyweights.

Playing alongside these heavyweights will be local youngsters playing in the U11, Cadet and Junior events. The main aims of the tournament are to promote Table Tennis and to introduce and encourage local youngsters to play table tennis.

The junior events and the qualifying groups of the Men's/Women's open singles will be played on Saturday 26th June. The Men's, Women's and Doubles events will be played to a conclusion on Sunday 27th June.

The Fusion All Star is only a few miles down the road from the lush lawns of Wimbledon where a new champion may be crowned this year. You may have to switch the All England Club for the Burger King Fusion All Star, and strawberry's and cream for jerk chicken, rice n peas. The profiles of the respective sports may also be worlds apart, with the winner of Wimbledon taking home £750,000 or more, compared to £1000 at the Fusion All Star, but all the ingredients are in place for some sizzling table tennis that is guaranteed rain or shine!!!
