

LEWIS GRAY SELECTED FOR WORLD SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Two 15 year old members of the Weald TT Club based at Angley School, Cranbrook, Lewis Gray and Yolanda King, have been selected for the first time to represent England in the International School Sport Federation World Schools' Championships in the Czech Republic from 25th to 31st March 2010. Players must be under 17 on 1st January 2010.

Lewis Gray, from Benenden and a pupil of Angley School, is ranked no.4 in England juniors (under 18) and is the current England and Home Countries under 16s school boys' champion. Yolanda King from Hastings and a pupil of St Bede's School, Hailsham, is ranked no.5 England junior girl and is a former England under 14s schoolgirl champion.

In addition to his World Schools' Championships selection, Gray has also been chosen to play for England in the Portugal Youth Open Championships in Tavia, Portugal from 18th – 20th December 2009. Also representing England cadets (under 15s) at the same event will be Judd School, Tonbridge pupil Helsham Weerasinghe, who attends the SE Regional Performance Centre at Angley School. Now firmly in the England squad having had his British nationality confirmed, Helshan will be attending England cadet training at Lilleshall National Sports Centre, Shropshire on 5th & 6th December 2009.
