Directions to: **The Howard School Table Tennis Centre, Derwent Way, Rainham Gillingham Kent ME8 OBX**

From M2: Exit at junction 4 and go straight down the A278, past Hempstead Valley Shopping centre on your left (first roundabout) and straight over the next roundabout and then at the next roundabout turn right past the large Tesco's supermarket. Carry on straight until you see the Football Centre on your right and as you go under the foot bridge get in the right lane to turn right into: Salisbury Avenue. Continue straight until you arrive at the T junction. At the T junction turn right into Derwent Way and the school entrance is straight ahead.

As you enter the school in Derwent Way go through the school gate and bear right towards the Howard School (not Rainham School for Girls on your right) and follow the road way around to the left and keep left when you see the front to the school reception. The Table Tennis Centre is at the back of the Howard School site, past the sports hall on your left. There is a car park right outside of the Centre.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. To enter, individuals must be eligible for the appropriate age group as follows: Under 11's born 2001 or later, Under 13's born 1999 or later, Under 15's (Cadet) born 1997 or later.
2. Completed and signed entry forms together with entry fees must be received by Monday 23rd January 2012 and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition (observing the regulations, abiding by the decisions of the organising committee and fulfilling the schedule of play unless prevented by circumstances beyond control and accepted as such), including storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
3. The tournament will run in accordance with E.T.T.A. regulations and the organisers' decision will be final.
4. Competitors may enter a maximum of TWO events, subject to age eligibility.
5. Competitors must report to the control table and book in upon arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.

6. The tournament committee (Mark Walsh Tel: 0785455550 and John Kemp Tel: 01795 841094 and Claire Moore) reserve the rights to cancel the tournament and to form a ratings/ranking system from match results.
7. Competitors will be permitted to practise on match tables at the discretion of the Tournament organisers.
8. Players should bring their own light refreshments, drinks and bats and arrive in their T.T. kit and trainers ready to play. Balls will be provided.
9. Players may be required to umpire matches if they lose the previous match and within their group.
10. The tournament will be played on a round robin basis in order that players participate in as many games as possible. England ranked players may be seeded (separated from the main drawer).
11. If necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
12. All decisions made by the umpires and organisers will be final and the tournament draw will take place on Weds. 25th January 2012.
13. Parents are at all times responsible for the welfare, behaviour and conduct of players/pupils and supporters.
14. An official photographer may be present and photographs of children may be used in future promotional material/newsletter/websites etc. If you wish to take photos/videos please report to the organisers desk upon arrival to seek permission and produce I.D.
15. Open to young people living and/or going to school in Kent County Council and Medway Council areas and London Boroughs of: Bexley, Bromley, Greenwich and Lewisham.
16. Girls and Boys will be mixed together in age groups (to ensure girls receive a good number of games) a separate girls event will be organised if there are sufficient numbers. Prizes will be awarded to those winners and runners up in each age group.
