This annual affiliation (payable to K.S.T.T.A.) allows schools and individuals to play in the K.S.T.T.A. team event and the K.S.T.T.A. individual tournament in February 2012, plus a small individual player entry fee.

Each team is to consist of 4 players in the same age group; U11s (Year 6), U13s (Year 7/8), U16 (Year 9/10/11) U19s (Year 12/13).

The winners of each age group will be invited to represent Kent in the E.S.T.T.A. Zone Final on a 14th/15th January 2012, at Morpeth School, Tower Hamlets.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. To enter, individuals within the team event, must be eligible for the appropriate age group and schools must be affiliated to the Kent Schools T.T.A. for 2011-2012 and pay the annual fee (see attached form) £12 per secondary school and £8 per primary school. Cheques to be made payable to, K.S.T.T.A. Schools may then enter both the team and individual tournament for that academic year.
2. The tournament will run in accordance with E.T.T.A. regulations and the organisers' decision will be final.
3. Games will best of 3/5 legs (depending on time), eleven up and change service every two points.
4. Players should bring their own light refreshments, drinks and bats and arrive in their P.E. kit and trainers ready to play. Balls will be provided.
5. Players may be required to umpire matches if they lose the previous match. Teachers may also be asked to umpire matches.
6. Teachers are at all time responsible for the welfare, behaviour and conduct of players/pupils and supporters.
7. An official photographer may be present and photographs of children may be used in future promotional material/newsletter/websites etc.
8. Ages shall be reckoned after the 31st August 2011 (e.g. a pupil aged 11 on or after 1st September 2011 will be eligible to play the U11 event).
9. Each team to consist of 4 players who must play in order of merit (see nominated players' list attached). A match will consist of 8 sets, each set being the best of 3/5 games to 11 up (depending on time). Order of play: 1v2, 2v1, 3v4, 4v3, 1v1, 3v2, 2v3, 4v4.
